Project Summary:

Glioblastoma is a difficult to treat brain cancer with limited therapeutic options. To help generate new treatments, such as immunotherapy, a greater understanding of how tumours affect the immune system is needed. As part of this research, we need to study non-patient immune cells. This is where you, the volunteer, can help.

Whats Involved:

Volunteers will be asked to donate 30ml of blood taken by a trained phlebotomist at Trinity Biomedical Sciences Institute, Trinity College Dublin. Project involvement will be strictly confidential.

Volunteer Criteria:

- Age 18 or older.
- No chronic infectious disease e.g. HIV-1
- No chemotherapy or radiotherapy the last 5 years.
- No prior central nervous system (brain and spine) cancer.
